**6:30 P.M. (PREVAILING TIME) TWP. COMMITTEE WORKSESSION MEETING**

Mayor Murphy opened the meeting in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act requirements.

Mayor Murphy presided with Committeemembers: DiCicco, O'Connor, Blessing and Crippen present.

**SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS OR DISCUSSIONS:**

James H. Pickering, Jr., Esq. was present representing Belleplain Emergency Corp. Mr. Pickering discussed the vacation of a portion of Washington Street in the Belleplain section of the Township. He shared a map depicting the area and advised the Committee that the Emergency Corp. needed the vacation to satisfy a requirement from the Pinelands regarding the area needed for the septic dilution standards for the existing septic system.

The Committee discussed the following:

**DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS AND PROJECT UPDATES:**

**Administration & Finance:**

The Committee discussed the quotes for the monitoring of the fire & alarm systems for the Township Hall and Senior Center. The Committee advised the Clerk that they feel its best to deal with one provider (Private Eyes) who already services the Museum and Recreation Center. They also indicated the advantages to dealing with a local vendor and instructed the Clerk to advise the Chief Finance Officer to take the necessary steps.

The Committee discussed the Township's policy regarding the consent of NJPDES permits. They requested that the Engineer review this issue and give a report at the next worksession.

The Committee discussed the correspondence from the County's Record Manager regarding the Records Mine program support we receive thru the County because of past PARIS grant funds. The Committee advised the Clerk that they wish to continue with the Records Mine program and when the County PARIS funds is complete we are to contract with the company Sunrise ourselves.

**Public Works & Engineering:**

The Engineer discussed the issue of the trees at the site of the Hagen Road & Dennisville Road intersection project.

The Engineer advised the Committee of a meeting with Pine Haven's Engineer to discuss the problems at Mr. Bandy's property.

The Engineer commented on the drainage issues at 888 Court House/So. Dennis Road.

**Tax Offices:**

The Committee discussed the request for a FMLA leave and advised the Clerk to place the resolution on the next agenda approving it. They also indicated that the Deputy Mayor would conduct interviews to hire a temporary Clerk Typist to fill in during leave in the Assessor's office.

**Legal:**

The Solicitor discussed adopting an ordinance that would establish guidelines and fees for Street Vacations. The Committee advised that Clerk to place this ordinance on an upcoming agenda for introduction.

**RESOLUTIONS:**
